#### **Building Hope Class Participants**

Participants in the most recent Building Hope 2 class listed the following as the most useful in the class content: learning how to eat heathy, how stress affects nutrition, what foods they should eat less of and the foods they should eat more of, the tips to organize their finances and important documents, the games that teach teamwork, the guide handed out to help budget money, and being able to ask questions in class.
