From grateful clients . . .

"In June, the Clearinghouse received a voice message from a woman feeling stressed as a result of the situations occurring in her life. One of these included a search for hearing aids that her daughter needed. Since this request is not something that the churches of Love INC usually provide for people, the clearinghouse researched a few options that might work for the mother who did not have much money to pay for the hearing aids. A volunteer called her back to give her these suggestions and the mom said, "I am very, very grateful that you took the time to return my call and listen and pray with me. Many other organizations were just matter of fact without any assistance and you put a smile on my face today." On that day this volunteer lived out a principle of Redemptive Compassion: See Everyone's Value. The volunteer took the time to listen, talk with her in a caring manner and point her to God in prayer, all because this mom is also a special creation of God.
