Redemptive Compassion in the Church and Community

Mid-Hudson Love In the Name of Christ began this year saying that we really were going to dig into Redemptive Compassion. The response to the material has been amazing. Four local churches have hosted small groups with their leadership teams and/or congregations, our Executive Director has led 2 small groups with Love INC volunteers from a mix of churches, and our Board of Directors has spent time wrestling with the principles each month at meetings. As an organization and as a ministry, the vision of Mid-Hudson Love In the Name of Christ is to see Christians united in service through Redemptive Compassion. Relational work is not always the easiest approach but it's always the right approach, and it's usually the most restorative one as well.
