To say 2020 has been a challenging year would be an understatement. But it is through the passion of our staff and volunteers that we have been able to overcome these challenges. We, along with the local churches, continue to be active in our community in supporting the needs of our neighbors through our Gap Ministry pantries, Relational Ministry classes, one-on-one Coaching, and Clearinghouse support, prayer and encouragement.

In spite of the pandemic, the Love INC network:

- Reached out to assist neighbors, during the COVID Pause period, in meeting emergency needs and made 365 check-in calls to neighbors to support, encourage and pray for them.
- Presented ten unique class offerings with 62 enrollments hosted by three local churches
- Heard countless testimonies from participants about the impact of community on their life
- United 200 volunteers in service across denominational lines
- Built a renewed vision on Redemptive Compassion, illustrating how to serve individuals in need wholistically physically, emotionally, relationally, and spiritually
- Kicked off a Coaching program for motivated neighbors
- Served approximately 225 neighbor households with resources

As we look to 2021, I'm confident, with God leading the way, this Mid-Hudson Love INC family can overcome any obstacles in achieving our goals.

Love Stories - Building Relationships

From a conversation with a neighbor during a recent delivery of personal care, a volunteer reported the neighbor saying how he is very grateful for the items and all the ways people of Love INC have helped him. As a result, he now "tries to pay it forward by volunteering at a food pantry at a local church".

Through the delivery of personal care, a neighbor and volunteer met for the first time. As they talked the neighbor shared that she would start a new part-time job that week and needed suitable work clothes, specifically black pants and a black shirt. The volunteer happened to have the right size of these clothes in a bag to donate and gave it to the neighbor. The neighbor stated how grateful she is for the prayer support when looking for a new job after losing her previous one in the COVID shutdown and for the kindness from an unexpected source.

♥ During a follow-up call with a neighbor, a clearinghouse volunteer heard of a neighbor's unfortunate change in their circumstances. The neighbor explained her story of how she and her husband and a small child lived at a shelter in the area and that once her husband abandoned her, the agency moved her to a new shelter (one that is known to be rather unkept and dirty) and she had to reapply for benefits since the previous ones were in her husband's name. The volunteer listened at length, offering comfort and prayer to her. The neighbor further explained that the new shelter did not provide breakfast and she did not have any money of her own. That day the volunteers in the clearinghouse decided to reach out to her, letting her know that someone cared for her life, by providing the breakfast food for her and her child. Volunteers continue to check on her to pray with and support her, as well as help connect her to resources for food.

O A Building Hope II student thanked Love INC for providing complimentary gloves, sanitizer and masks and commented "It really shows that you guys care about us, and that means a lot".

Relational Ministry

The Post-Class survey for the first Affirming Potential class revealed:

- 1. 50% of the graduates reported an increased sense of hope, value, and unique purpose.
- 2. 9 out of 10 class participants indicated they planned to making positive changes as a result of the class.
- 3. Student comments: "I learned to plan things out before acting"; "I am more open to change than I was before"; "I budget better and make my budget every month".

The Post-Class survey from a recent Building Hope II class revealed:

- 1. 85% of the graduates reported learning new information and skills that they will use in everyday life.
- 2. Student comments: Inspired by the class on healthy eating, one student decided to make healthier choices for breakfast each morning. Another participant wanted the class to know that he used the gift card he received in class to buy healthy food. His food purchases included salad, dressing, and orange juice.
