#### **OUR MISSION**

In spite of all the pandemic challenges, 2021 was a very fulfilling and successful year for the Mid-Hudson Love INC ministry. The creativity, flexibility and commitment of our staff and volunteers continues to drive our success in serving our neighbors during these unsettled times. The number of help requests received and households served continued to increase this year making the varying Gap Ministry deliveries that much more critical for our neighbors\*. We were able to enhance our

Relational Ministry class offerings by introducing two new classes – Faith and Finance and Resolving Everyday Conflicts, which were very well received by those attending. After 18 months, the two remaining Coaching teams came to a successful closure in assisting our neighbors in achieving their goals. Both Coaches and neighbors found it to be a very rewarding experience. An initial Stepping Stone Grant was awarded to assist a neighbor in obtaining resources to return to college. The initial phase of our Children's Ministry Program to implement a children's class centered around spiritual growth has been completed with the first class starting in March 2022. Finally, partnering with churches, we had the privilege to provide neighbors in need with Thanksgiving Baskets, Christmas Food Baskets, and Christmas Children's Gifts\*.

As we enter 2022, plans are to continue to grow the Relational Ministry class offerings by adding a *Healthy Lifestyles Workshop* where neighbors can learn and experience a healthy regimen. With more graduates expected, we hope to grow the team of *Coaches* to assist neighbors in achieving their defined goals. We're exploring future *Children's Ministry Program* plans involving mentoring and teen initiatives. We would like to also offer *Redemptive Compassion* study groups throughout the year to share the wholistic approach to caring for our neighbors so be on the lookout for these opportunities.

The continued support from the churches, volunteers, and community throughout 2021 has been so appreciated. Together, in partnership with local churches, we will continue to transform lives in our community.

As we look back at the past year, we see the support we found in people around us and the same is true for our neighbors who united with Mid-Hudson Love In the Name of Christ. #### RELATIONAL MINISTRY



This past year, we gathered and grew in so many ways through our Relational Ministry classes and one-on-one coaching program. Our classes of Building Hope, Spiritual Exploration, Faith & Finances and Resolving Everyday Conflicts were a place for our neighbors to learn valuable life skills, study the Word, pray for one another and share their stories. We heard how the classes helped them "focus on being a better person," taught them "coping skills to deal with stress," and showed them "how to budget and pay off my debt," while others said the connections, relationships and support they received from the volunteer teachers and from one another helped them restore hope through tough times. As the class participants grow in faith and make positive life changes, we see transformation starting in their lives. One neighbor told us, "I am no longer stuck in the place I was a year ago and

am so grateful that Love INC has put me on this path". In the year ahead, we trust God will continue to guide us in fulfilling His purpose for our Relational Ministry programs as we continue to gather together and grow for His glory!

#### **New Children's Ministry Coordinator Hired!**



Mid-Hudson Love INC is pleased to announce the hiring of **Susan K. Buckley** in the new position of Children's Ministry Coordinator. Starting in March 2022, she will facilitate classes for the children of adults attending Relational Ministry classes.

Sue comes to Love INC with decades of experience working with children in a variety of settings. She served for many years in Children's Sunday School and Vacation Bible School programs at New Beginnings, and has volunteered with many other organizations including the Girl Scouts. In addition, Sue is a retired educator, working over 22 years at New York State Office of Children and

Family Services as a teacher of incarcerated youth.

Sue is passionate about the calling to minister to children, "Teaching children about God is the most important work/privilege we have as Christians. My love of God and teaching children cannot be separated."

We are excited to welcome Sue to the Love INC Children's Ministry program. This part-time position is made possible through a grant from the Jeannette F. Schlobach Fund of the Community Foundations of the Hudson Valley.

#### A Neighbor's Stepping Stone Grant Love Story

In 2021, a *Stepping Stone Grant* was implemented to assist neighbors in funding all or part of a specific goal, up to a maximum \$500. Goals are identified during the final core class and with the assistance of an assigned Coach, a plan is developed to achieve the goal.

The initial grant was awarded to a neighbor, who briefly attended college a few years ago, but unfortunately had to drop out due to personal life situations. After attending Love INC classes, this neighbor identified a goal of returning to college to obtain a degree. In working with his Coach, he was able to develop a plan to return to college, which quickly identified the need for assistance in purchasing a computer. He and his Coach researched viable options and derived a solution for a laptop and amenities totaling \$500. The grant provided the funding to make the purchases and his goal a reality to return to college to continue his studies. The neighbor commented, "I am really happy to have this goal of returning to school. It is a step I've needed to take for a while now, and I finally feel ready to do this. I am in such a better position now than I have been before, and this opportunity gives me something positive to work towards. It is fulfilling a dream for me."



In 2021, **147** volunteers from **33** churches invested over **8,260** hours in ministry through Mid-Hudson Love INC! That equates to **\$235,740\*.** Please refer to 'Ministry Impact' on page 1 for a summary of their accomplishment in serving those in need.


