I'd like to express my gratitude and heartfelt appreciation to all our **volunteers** who support Mid-Hudson Love INC with such passion and dedication. This critical support is shown in a variety of ways across Love INC in our Clearinghouse, Relational and Gap Ministries.

Some examples of the various ways volunteers support Love INC are:

- Teaching, providing transportation and donating incentive items for 11 Relational Ministry classes with 48 neighbors participating in one or more classes, filling 69 seats.
- Teaching and supporting six youth in the debut of the Children's Ministry class for those children of parents taking classes.
- Providing mentoring, support and prayer for three graduates pursuing their goals through our Coaching program.
- Donating and delivering 690 items to-date to our neighbors through the Gap Ministry providing personal care, pillows, towels, linens, furniture, household goods and beds.
- Handling 708 calls to-date in the Clearinghouse from neighbors requesting assistance.
- Praying over weekly requests our Prayer Warriors in the Prayer Ministry receive, as well as providing a monthly Prayer Calendar (<a href="www.mid-hudsonloveinc.org">www.mid-hudsonloveinc.org</a>) so that we can be a community in prayer.
- Participating on the Board and committees to ensure efficiency in the services provided.

The impact that our volunteers make in building relationships, restoring hope, and transforming lives is evident. I continue to be encouraged through this partnership and look forward to future opportunities to serve together to be God's hands and feet in ministering to those in need in our community.

## **Building Relationships**

The furniture team delivered on two occasions to fulfill a new neighbor's request. On both dates the team delivered, the neighbor was experiencing difficult life circumstances; one time the neighbor's brother was in a serious accident and the next time the neighbor was robbed. The team took the time to talk with her to learn how she was doing and to find out what was happening in her life. The team joined in prayer for her after loading the furniture into her apartment.

Over the course of the past couple of months, a volunteer reconnected with a neighbor. As they talked each week, the volunteer heard the neighbor express how she really wanted to learn more about the Bible and own a Bible that she could read on her own. The volunteer readily began to pursue making this happen. The volunteer consulted with her pastor about an appropriate study guide and, also, researched and purchased a good version of the Bible with large print and with vocabulary appropriate to the neighbor's reading ability. A second neighbor made a similar request resulting in both neighbors and the volunteer meeting twice a month to enjoy afternoons of study and prayer.
