TRANSFORMATION

Transformation is about modifying core beliefs and long-term behaviors, or simply put from a Love INC perspective, working with our neighbors to reach a sustainable level of improvement in their lives. The Love INC ministry model is relational which is key to transformation because a long-term relationship builds community and trust that enables us to

walk alongside each neighbor and explore with them their God given potential. When passionate, trained Christians engage in their community, like our staff and volunteers do, healthy relationships grow, and struggling neighbors receive support, friendship, and the kind of practical help they need.

Almost every category represented in the 'Ministry Impact' section showed an increase in 2022 signifying the growing need in our community and the importance and impact of serving our neighbors. We have addressed the needs through Gap Ministry partnerships and offerings. New classes have been added resulting from goals identified by our neighbors. We have bolstered our Children's Ministry with a Bible led class and a Family Fun Day including filled backpacks. Youth Ministry initiatives are being pursued with churches. Our Coaching team is growing to assist neighbors in achieving their goals. It is only through the commitment and passion of our volunteers and staff that over time relationships blossom and transformation is experienced by everyone – neighbors, volunteers, staff, and churches.

As you read the stories and testimonies in this Annual Report, look to see how these love stories intersect, using many of God's people to bring about transformation. God is truly at work through the Love INC family.

In 2022, **158** volunteers from **33** churches invested over **7,590** hours in ministry through Mid-Hudson Love INC! That equates to **\$227,321** according to the *Independent Sector* which estimates the national value of \$29.95 for each 2022 volunteer hour.

A neighbor, who experienced the loss of several loved ones this past year and stayed connected to volunteers, called recently to let us know how she is doing and to share her gratitude for all the volunteers who have supported her this year. The volunteer described the spirit of the call as 'incredible'. The neighbor said she is "so very grateful for the cards and constant prayers from the people of Love INC" and is experiencing the healing of God through it. The neighbor further said, "It feels like bricks have been lifted off my shoulder." It's amazing to see how God used the many volunteers in her life and how God brought her through difficult situations.

Volunteers

I met a very special neighbor about 8 years ago. Her life is so very hard. I cannot take the struggles away, but I try to show God's love and make it a little easier. We talk about once a week to see how she is doing. I deliver personal care items from Love INC and food from our church pantry. I give her rides to run errands. She loves lunch out at Panera for her birthday and Christmas. Most of these holidays make her anxious because she does not like to celebrate. For Christmas every year she has made me a Christmas ornament and a special card. letting me know how much she appreciates our visits. Other times during the year she will send cards offering thanks and praising God for us being together. This relationship has shown me a different life than I live. The many financial issues, cancer she survived and continued health struggles, and lack of close relationships has caused a lot of anxiety which has made her feel hopeless at times. God is so good to connect us together for it is in serving him we both have grown in our Faith.

Last spring one Love INC neighbor divulged that she had a deep fear of death. I offered to do a Bible study with her imagining that a session would suffice to express the gospel to her and invite her to put her faith in Jesus. At the Clearinghouse we didn't realize that another Love INC neighbor had been a friend of our previous neighbor since they were both about 8 years old. Both neighbors wanted to be part of this Bible study together. These women were so joyful and thirsty for opportunities for growth in social, literacy and biblical directions. We met 6 times to study the gospel of Mark in which I observed exciting improvement before health problems and schedule conflicts combined to bring the study to an end. These two friends' friendship of about 67 years had begun to unravel under their health and family problems. 
